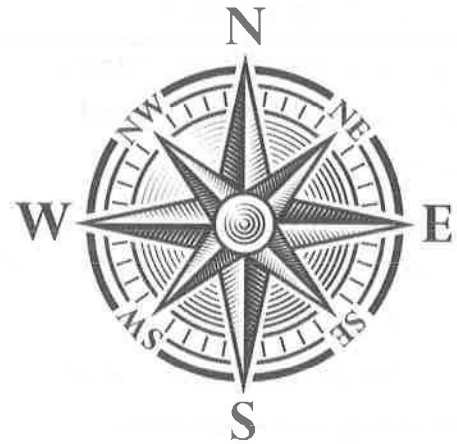

A compass rose is a symbol that is used on maps. It shows the position on the map of each of the cardinal directions (north, south, east, and west). Use your finger to show which way each of the cardinal directions points. The intermediate directions are in between.
