

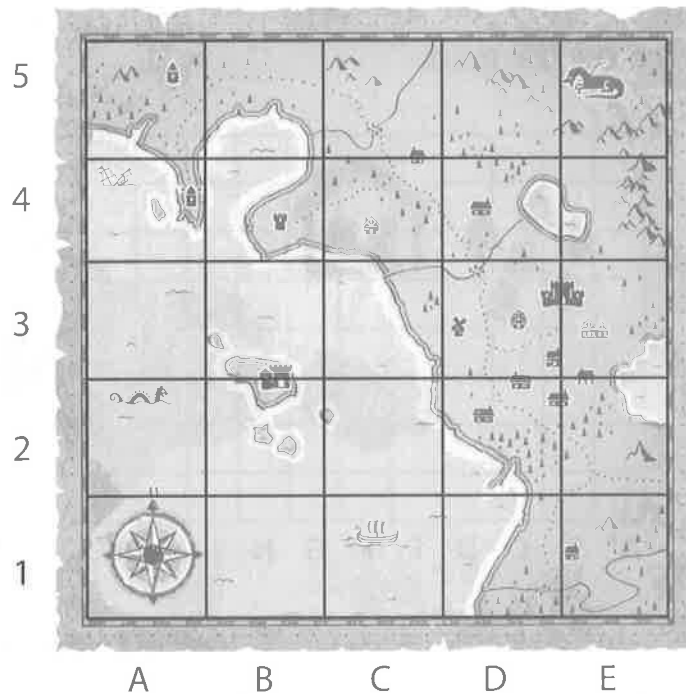

A topographic map shows you what is on the ground. When you look at the map, you are looking down at the ground from above.

Topographic maps can show hills, rivers, and wetlands. They can show things we build, such as bridges, railway tracks, and buildings.

Look at the grid. It has numbers and letters. Follow the letters across the bottom first. Then, follow the numbers up the side. To find the dragon, follow letter E up and number 5 across. The dragon is at E, 5.
